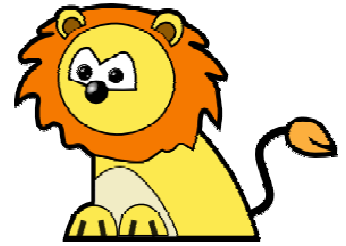


Fort Lewis Elementary School Roaring Report

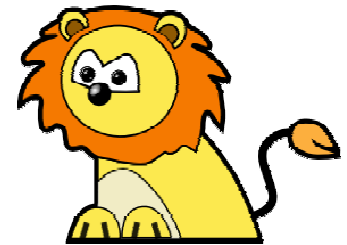

Kroger Cares Gift Card Program

Fort Lewis Elementary PTA has teamed up with Kroger for an Innovative new approach to fundraising! This is a fundraiser where you as parents, teachers and friends of Fort Lewis can give to the school without ANY out of pocket expenses!

All you have to do is “purchase” a gift card through PTA for \$5.00. When you receive your special gift cards, which will say Kroger and FLES on the front, each one you purchase for \$5.00 will have \$5.00 on it, which you may then spend at any Kroger store, so there is no cost to you.

Once you get your card through PTA, you go to shop at Kroger and get all of your regular groceries, gas, pharmacy needs, etc. When you get to the cash register, before the clerk checks you out or scans any of your items, you present your special FLES Kroger gift card and either cash, check or credit/debit card to them and ask them to load \$50, \$100, \$150....any amount up to \$500 onto your Kroger card. Then they scan your items and tell you your purchase total. You then slide your FLES Kroger card through the credit card machine and 5% of your total purchase is automatically given to FLES! It’s really that easy!!! No expense other than your regular grocery costs and very small effort, to give a lot back to our school!

Please do “purchase” your card today and **use it every time you shop or get your gas at Kroger**. This could be the easiest fundraiser we ever do at FLES and we could ALL make a difference in the funding of many programs and purchases for our school to use for our children, all year long, every year. These cards never “expire” and can be reloaded over and over and they still keep giving 5% to our school account, as long as you use your card at least once every 90 days.
